Vaccination Requirements

The health and safety of all participants in *Concerts at Saint Thomas* is a top priority. To support a safe reopening for in-person events, and in accordance with the advice of medical and public health experts, all concert-goers attending *Concerts at Saint Thomas* will be required to show valid proof of vaccination upon arrival. Face masks will be required depending on the CDC, state, and local guidelines at the time of the performance.

We will need to see in-person proof of a complete course of vaccination with a vaccine approved by the [U.S. Food and Drug Administration](#) (FDA) or by the [World Health Organization](#) (WHO) (links here). This includes entering the premises at least two weeks after the second dose of a two-dose vaccine or at least two weeks after a single dose of a one-dose vaccine.

Prior to entering Saint Thomas Church, you will be asked to provide valid proof of vaccination. Proof of vaccination may include:

- NYC COVID Safe App
- Excelsior Pass
- CDC Vaccination card (or photo)
- NYC Vaccination Record
- An official immunization record from outside NYC or the United States.

If you received the vaccine outside the U.S., you must have an official immunization record that includes:

- First name and last name
- Date of birth
- Vaccine product name (only vaccines authorized by the FDA or WHO are acceptable)
- Date(s) administered
- Site where the vaccine was administered, or name of the person who administered it

Our staff will review your proof of vaccination as you arrive.

- Members of the audience under the age of 12 will be admitted but must wear a mask at all times.
- Proof of recover from COVID-19 is not a valid form for entry.

Ticketing Policies

We have reviewed our ticket policies to make sure we are as flexible and accommodating as possible in the event you are unable to attend a performance. The 2021–22 ticket policy has been updated to include flexible exchanges for all ticket buyers. If you are unable to attend a performance for any reason, you will be eligible for a complimentary exchange to any future performance. Exchanges may be requested up until the performance start time, and ticket buyers will be asked to pay the difference in price should the replacement performance ticket price exceed that of the original ticket.
