Originally from London, UK, prize-winning organist, conductor, and pianist, Tyrone Whiting is Director of Music & Arts at the historic Church of St. Martin-in-the-Fields, Philadelphia, USA.

Tyrone graduated from the Royal College of Music as a scholar from the Postgraduate Diploma in Performance Science course, where he was generously funded by an Arts and Humanities Research Council Studentship and supported by the Douglas and Hilda Simmonds Award. Returning to the RCM in 2016, Tyrone achieved a distinction in the Master of Music degree and received the renowned Harold Darke Prize in 2017.

Tyrone maintains an active performance and teaching career and has played venues across the USA, the UK, and Europe. Recent and future performances include St. Patrick's Cathedral, New York; Longwood Gardens, Pennsylvania; the International Düsseldorf Orgelfest, Germany; and Princeton University Chapel, as well as performing for the third year as MC for the Philadelphia Orchestra & Kimmel Center's Organ Day in 2024.

Passionate about teaching, Tyrone holds the Licentiateship diploma of Trinity College, London (LTCL) in Instrumental/Vocal Teaching with a high distinction and continues to work as a teacher of organ, piano, conducting, and theory. He was formerly Head of Music at Elmhurst Independent School for Boys for many years and worked as an animateur in London schools and with the London Mozart Players. He continues to offer masterclasses and visiting lectures in his busy portfolio career.
