Connor has taught organ at Lehigh University and often performs as a solo organist and pianist, as well as an accompanist and continuo player. When not behind the keyboard, he also sings in the bass section of the Philadelphia Symphonic Choir, as well as with Princeton Pro Musica and other local ensembles. Outside of music, Connor is an avid reader and cinephile, and is usually planning some overly ambitious cooking project.
