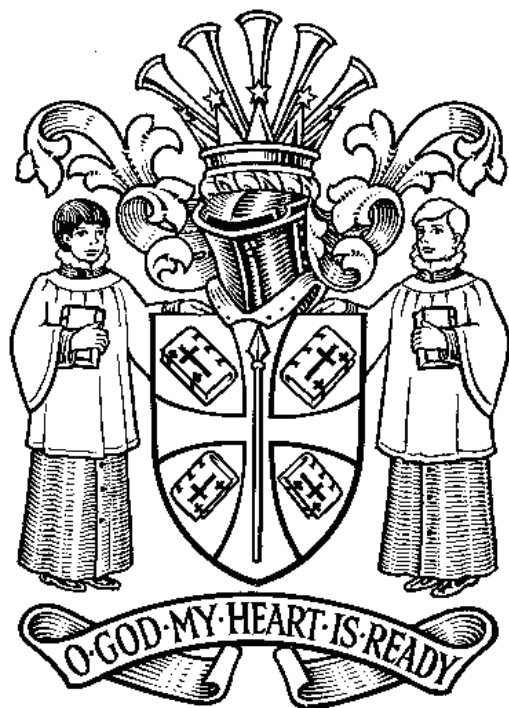

THE SAINT THOMAS CHOIR OF MEN AND BOYS

The Saint Thomas Choir of Men and Boys is considered to be the leading ensemble of its kind in the Anglican choral tradition in the United States. While its primary *raison d'être* is to sing five choral services each week, the choir also performs regularly with Orchestra of St. Luke's and New York Baroque Incorporated as part of the Saint Thomas Church concert series. Live webcasts of choral services and further information concerning recordings, tours and concerts given by the choir can be found at *SaintThomasChurch.org*.

Over recent years, the choir has toured throughout the US, Europe and Scandinavia with performances at Westminster Abbey and St. Paul's Cathedral in London, King's College, Cambridge, the Aldeburgh Festival, at the Vatican, and in Dresden and at the Thomaskirche in Leipzig. Domestically, the choir has appeared often at National AGO Conventions. Besides annual performances of Handel's *Messiah*, the choir's concerts at Saint Thomas Church have included presentations of the Fauré, Duruflé and Mozart *Requiems*, the J. S. Bach *Passions*, Handel's *Israel in Egypt* and James MacMillan's *Seven Last Words from the Cross*.

In 2016, a concert in memory of former Director of Music John Scott was performed with Orchestra of St. Luke's under the direction of Sir Simon Rattle. The choir has made many commercial recordings, most recently in 2026 for an upcoming album inspired by the long-line of esteemed musicians who have been associated with Saint Thomas Church under the direction of Director of Music Richard Tanner.

Other recent recordings have included an album of the Music of Gerre Hancock (Signum), Propers for the Feast of Corpus Christi by William Byrd (Signum), a Christmas album, *No Small Wonder* (Acis), and albums featuring the works of Calvin Hampton and Kenneth Leighton (Signum). The Gentlemen of the Choir are all professional singers working here in New York, and the Boy Choristers live at the historic Saint Thomas Choir School and are educated in collaboration with New York's Professional Children's School.

SAINT THOMAS CHOIR SCHOOL

Saint Thomas Choir School, in the heart of New York City, is home to the treble choristers of the Saint Thomas Choir of Men and Boys, one of the nation's leading ensembles in the Anglican choral tradition. Boys in grades 4–8 live at the Choir School, receive their academic education at Professional Children's School, and take part in an intensive musical program centered around singing five services each week at historic Saint Thomas Church Fifth Avenue. The Choir also performs regularly in concert, in New York, across the country, and around the world.

At Saint Thomas Choir School, the boys live in community with full-time residential staff, sharing in the rhythms of daily life—from family-style meals and afternoon sports to bedtime snacks and books. Through this unique combination of music, education, and community, the choristers form deep friendships and develop confidence, independence, and a profound sense of service, all while immersing themselves in a shared passion for music.
